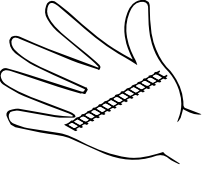
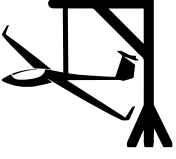
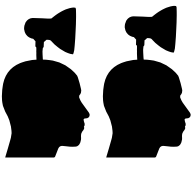
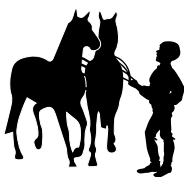


Picture Play 12
