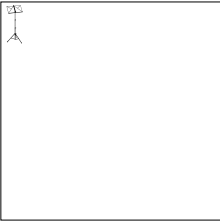
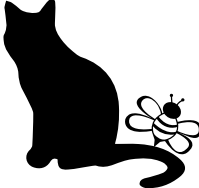
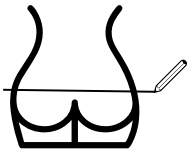
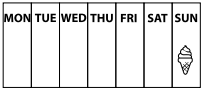


Picture Play 13
