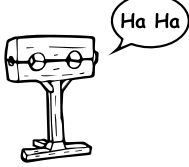
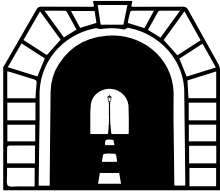
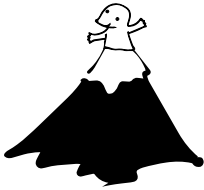
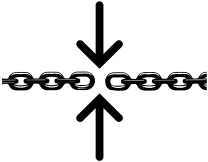
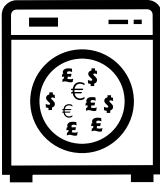
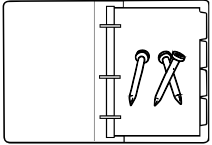


Picture Play 15
