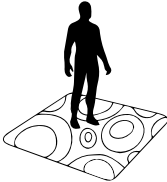
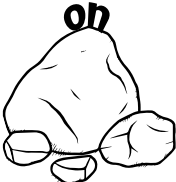
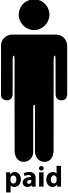
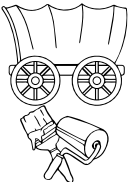
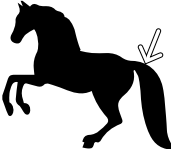
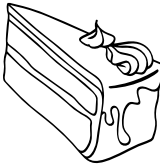


Picture Play 16
