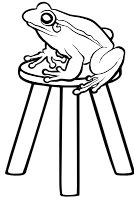
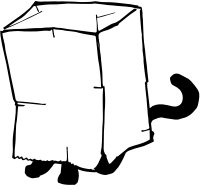
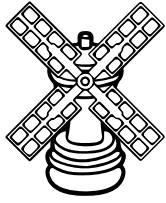
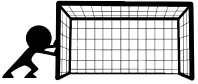


Picture Play 4
