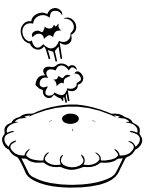
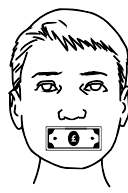
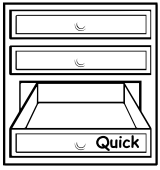
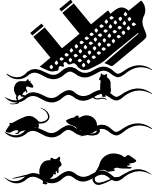
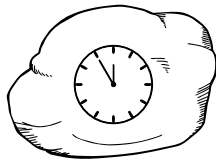
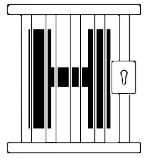
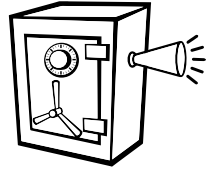
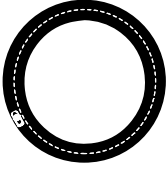
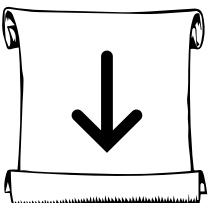


Picture Play 6
