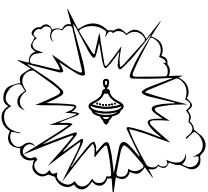
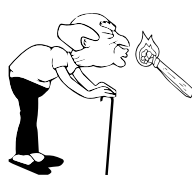
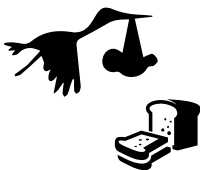
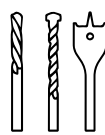
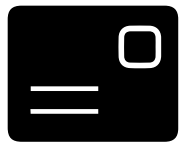


Picture Play 8
