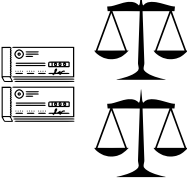
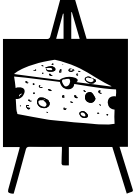
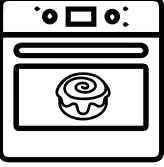
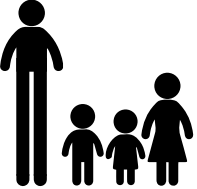


Picture Play 9
