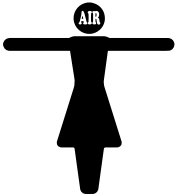
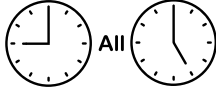
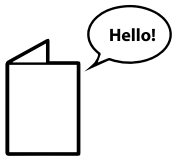


Picture Words 1

Picture Words 1 use both pictures and words (as the name suggests) to describe another word, expression, or phrase in common usage. They are a mix of Pictograms and Wordies, in essence, Picture Words 1 are many rebuses. According to the OED, a Rebus is a puzzle in which words are shown by using combinations of pictures and letters; for instance, apex might be represented by a picture of an ape followed by a letter X. The earliest known use of the noun rebus is in the early 1600s.
