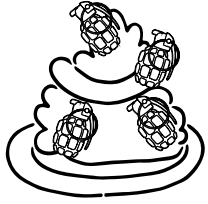
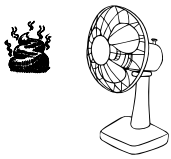
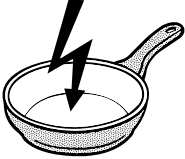
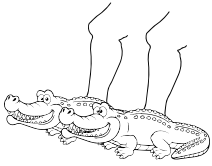
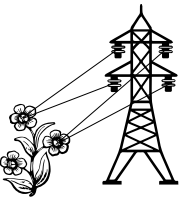
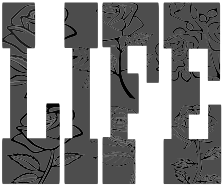
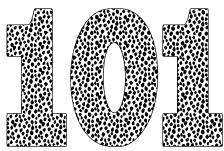
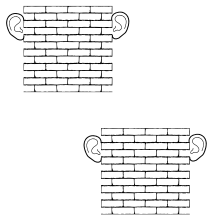


Picture Play 2
