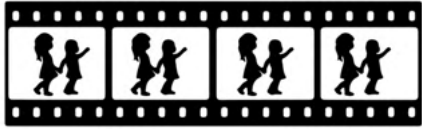
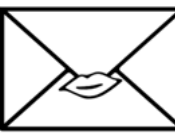
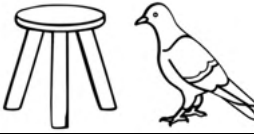
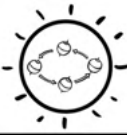


Song Pictograms 2
