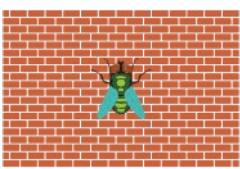
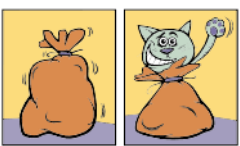
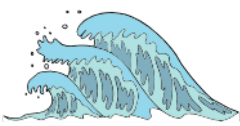
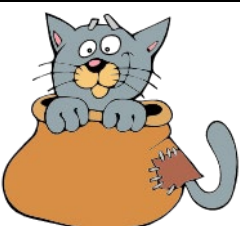
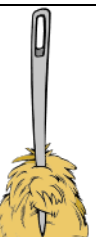
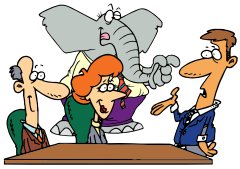
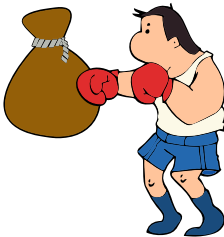


Idioms 3
