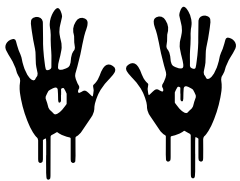
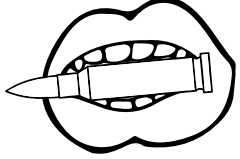
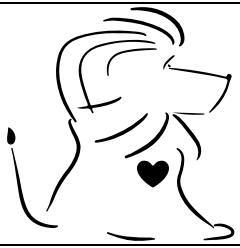
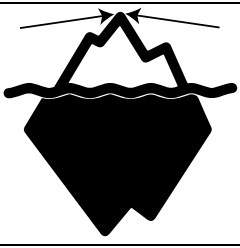
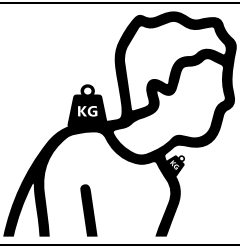
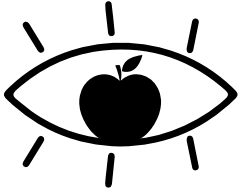
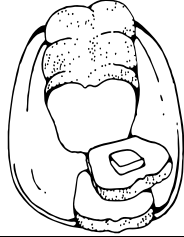


Metaphors 1
