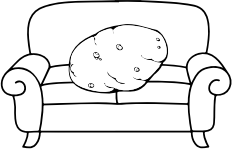
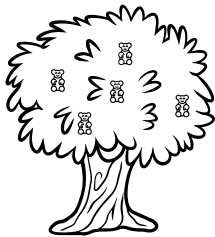
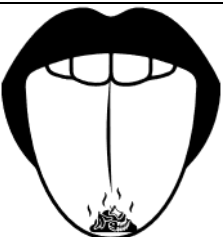
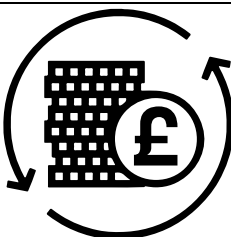
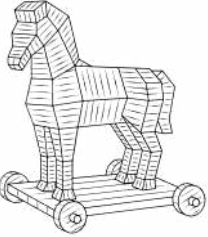
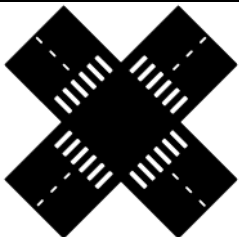
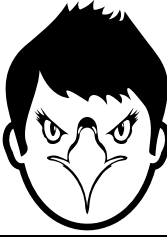
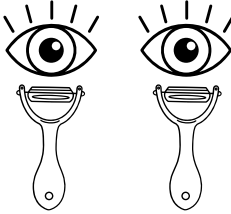
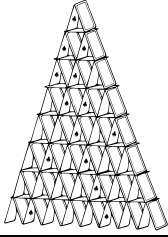


Metaphors 2
