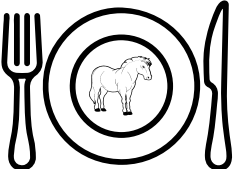
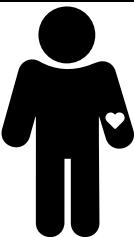
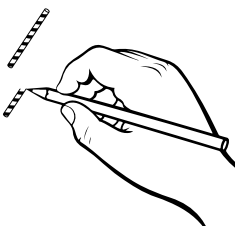
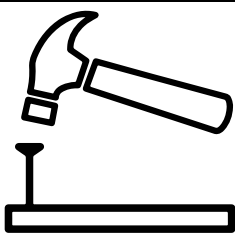
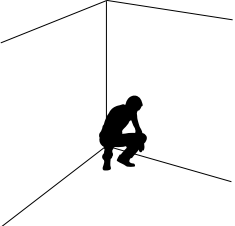
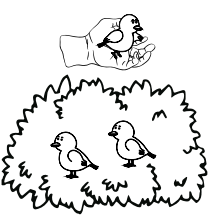
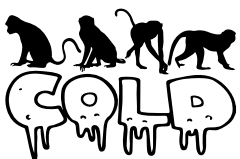
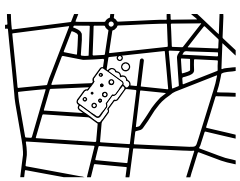
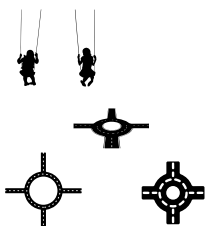
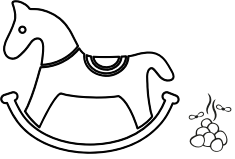
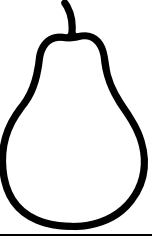
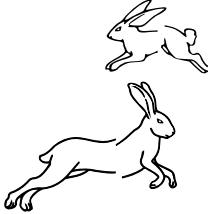
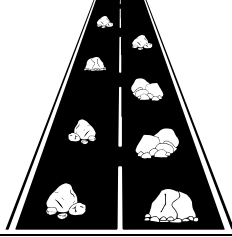


Metaphors 3
