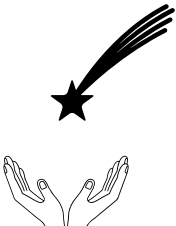
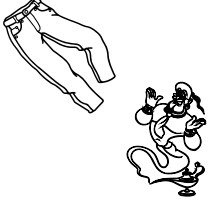
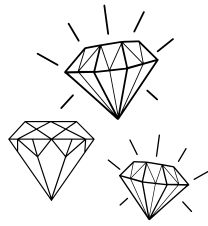
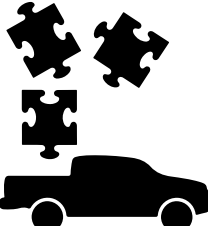
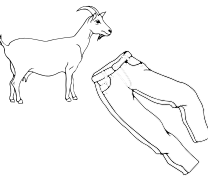
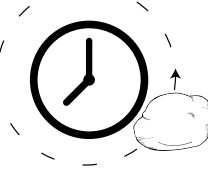
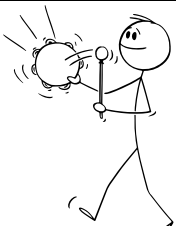
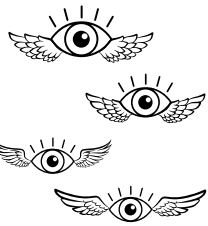
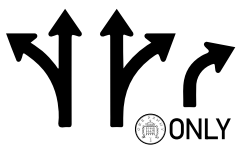


Song Pictograms 05
