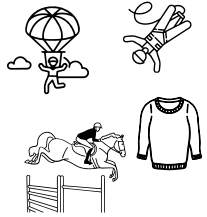
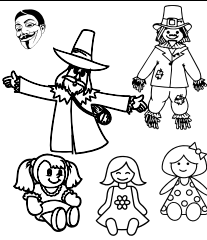
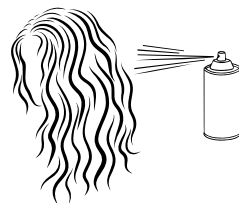
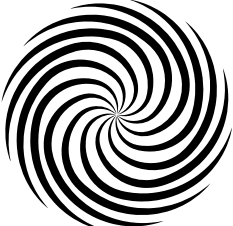
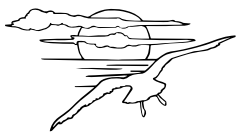
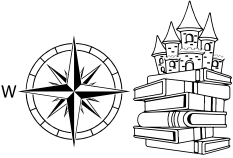
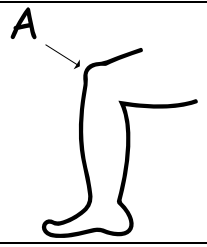


Stage Pictograms 2
