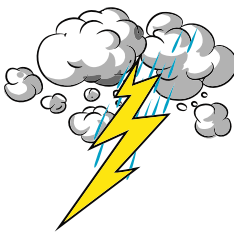
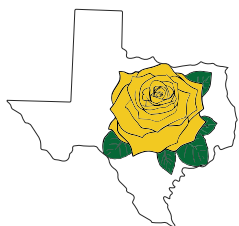
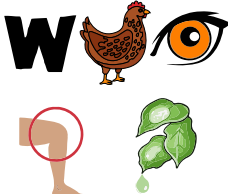
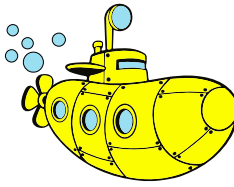


Song Pictograms 08
