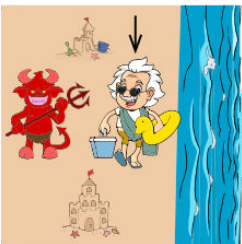
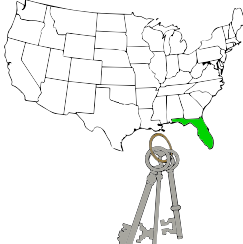
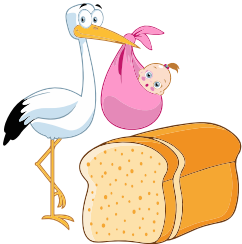
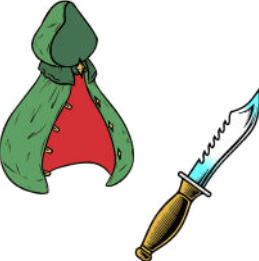
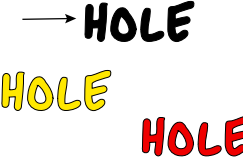
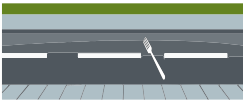
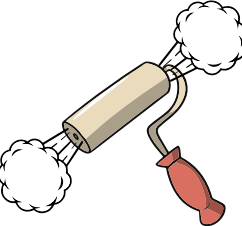
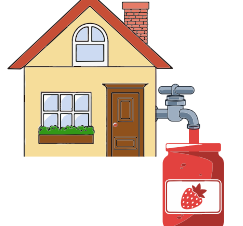


Pictograms
