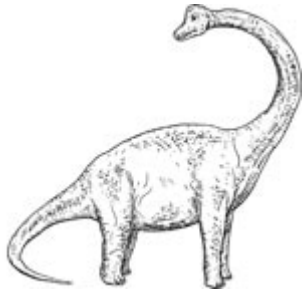
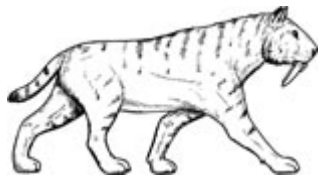
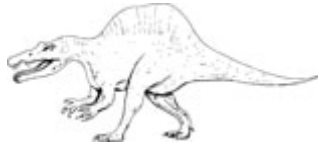
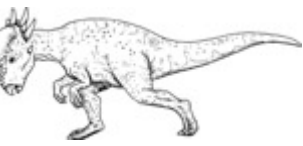
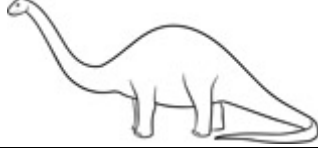
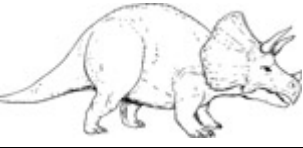
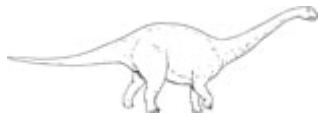
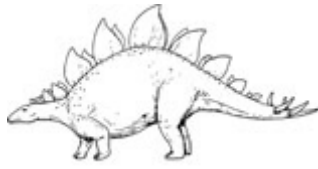
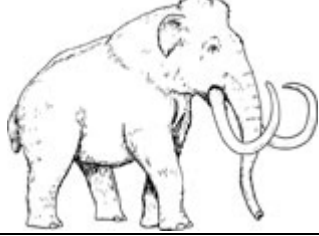
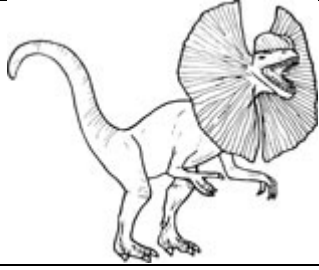
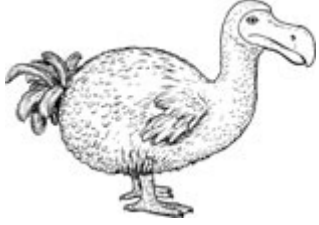


Extinct Animals
