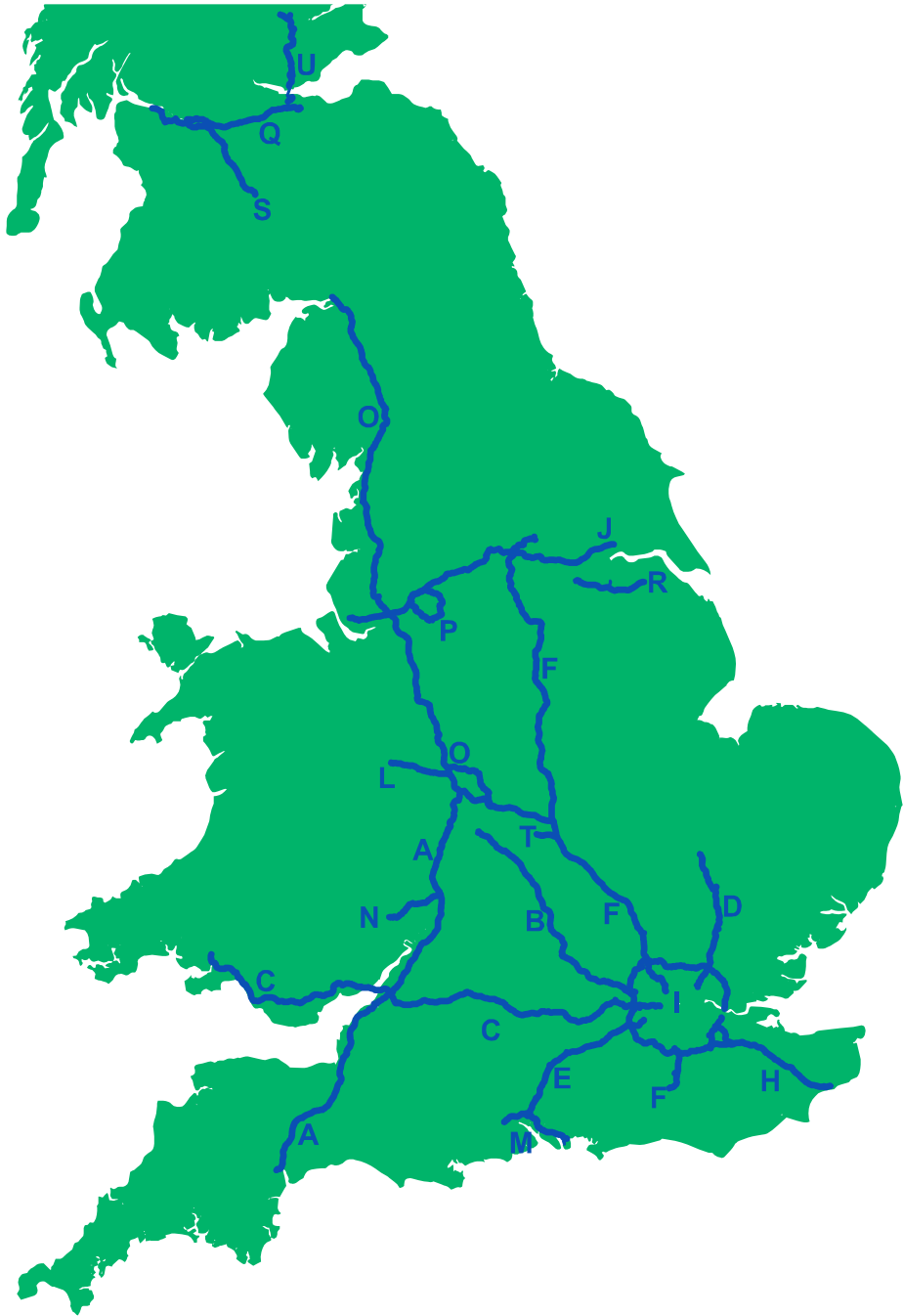


British Motorways

There are more than 2000 miles of British motorways. The first British motorway was the Preston Bypass in Lancashire, opening in 1958 and now part of the M6 which at 236 Miles (380 km) is the longest in Britain.
