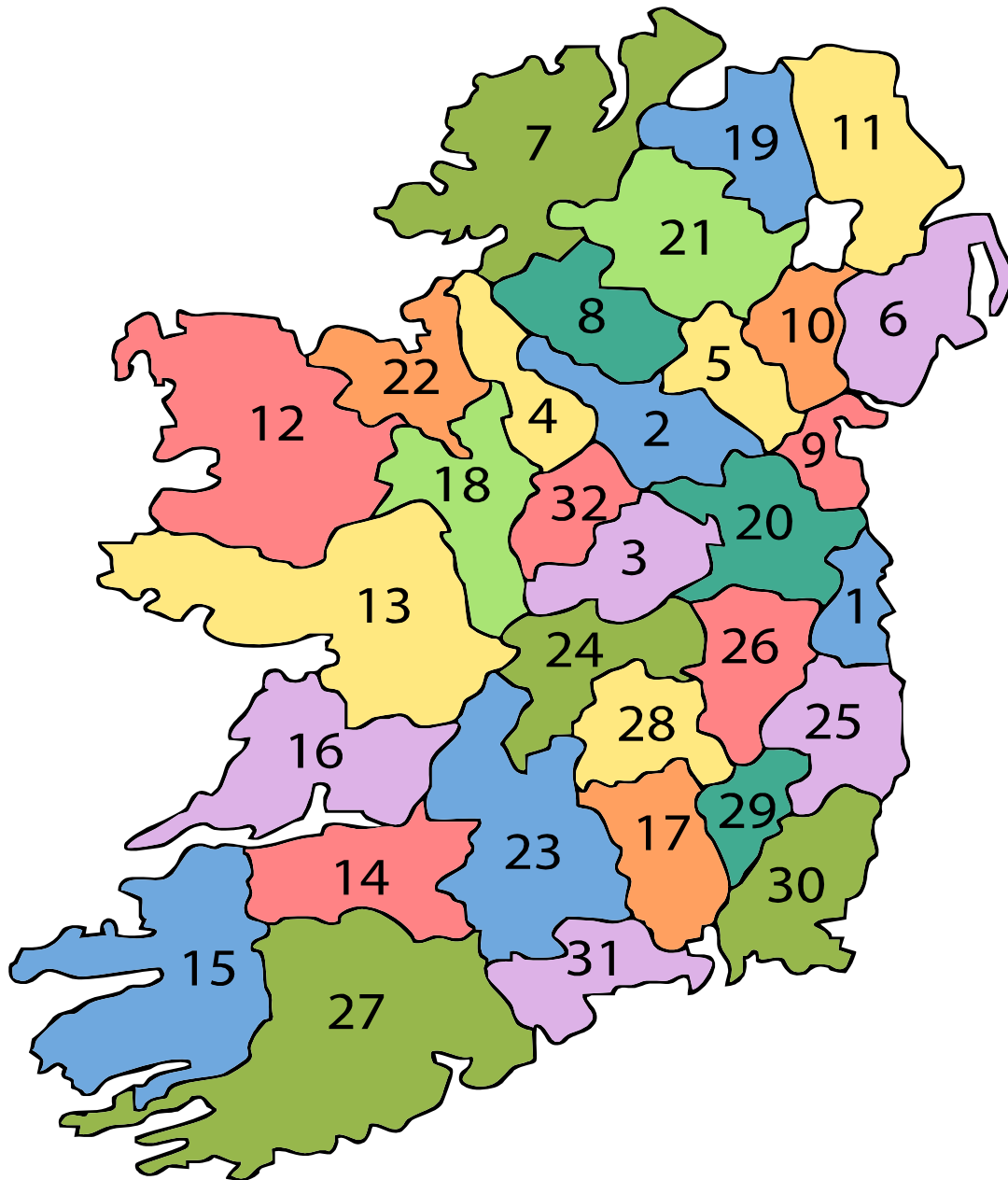


Counties of the Island of Ireland
