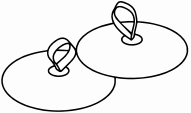
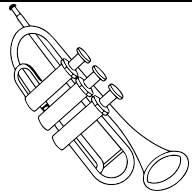
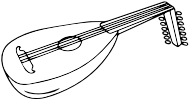
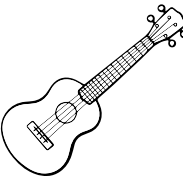
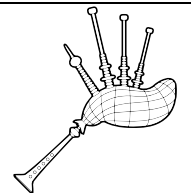
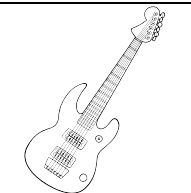
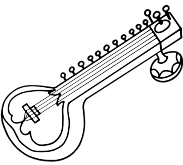
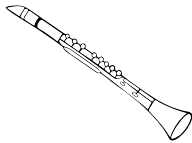
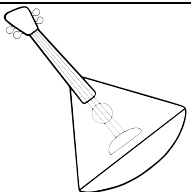
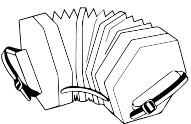
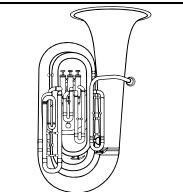
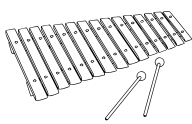
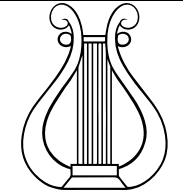
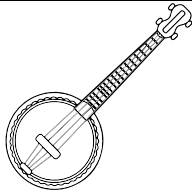


Musical Instruments
