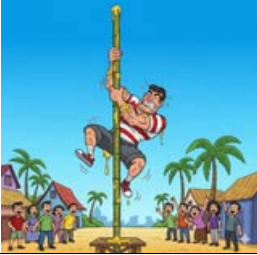
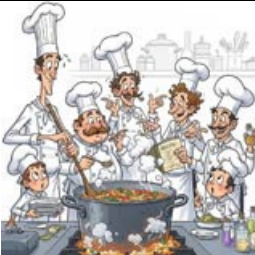


Sayings 06
