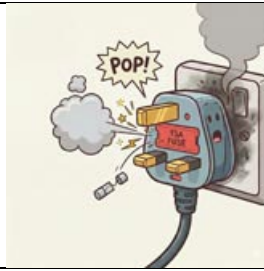


Common Expressions 02
